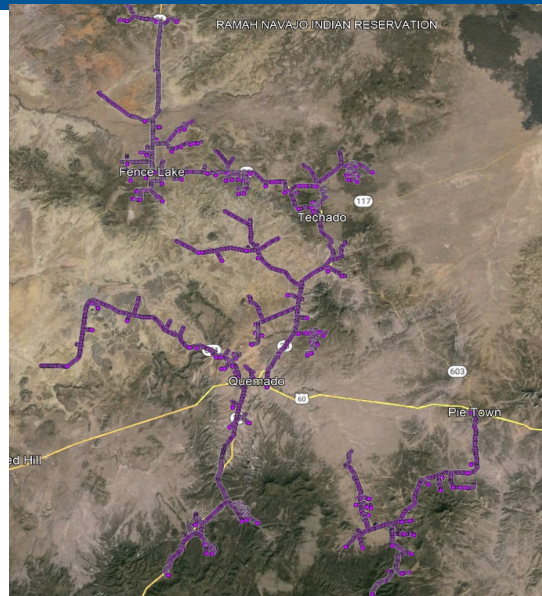




# SEC Contractor Alamon to be Conducting Pole Inspections

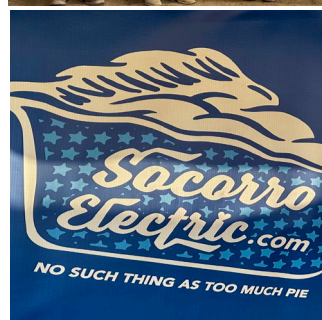
