



Reminder to use our Free Mobile-Friendly "App" to pay Your Bill

We would like to remind our Members of our mobile application for both Google's Android and Apple's iOS platforms. SEC members can utilize the App to conveniently manage their account from virtually anywhere in the world including paying your electric bill..

To download the free SEC App and start your new interactive experience with us, go to the Google Play Store for Android devices or to the App Store for Apple devices and search for "Socorro Electric Cooperative".



The official SEC App is titled "Socorro EC" and has our official mobile App logo as seen here to the left. Once the SEC App is downloaded and installed on your smartphone or mobile device, you will be able to access your account the same as if you accessed the SEC website on-line.



Note: you must have a SEC Customer Portal on-line account setup prior to using this App. This can be accessed from our website at: www.socorroelectric.com under "Pay Online".

With the app on your device, you have the ability to view your accounts, view your bills, make secure payments directly from your mobile device, view your payment history, modify or maintain your subscriptions for alerts and reminders, and contact us via email or phone.

All of the information on the App is shown in real-time so it is always accurate. This App is very secure as all critical information is encrypted in every transaction run through the App and no personal information is stored on your mobile device.

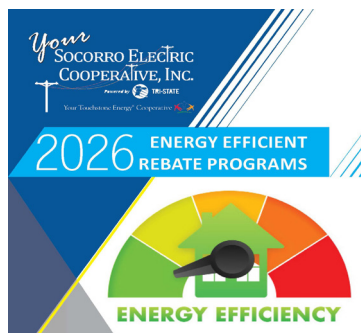
New Energy Efficiency Rebate Changes for 2026!

Since 1985, Tri-State and SEC have partnered to promote the wise use of electricity, energy efficiency, and implementation of new electric technologies. Today, Socorro Electric is helping members move forward to promote beneficial electrification to increase efficiency and productivity, create sustainable and load growth, reduce carbon emissions, and enhance safety.

Some of the highlights for the 2026 Energy Efficiency Rebates are:

- Clarified that line voltage thermostats do not require EnergyStar certification.
- Heat pump program clarifications - Ducted, dual fuel, bonus rebate eligibility expanded to include both propane and natural gas and is applied after the rebate is calculated.
- Clarified the definition of a whole house fan.
- Revised & clarified EV charger rebate value eligibility requirements.
